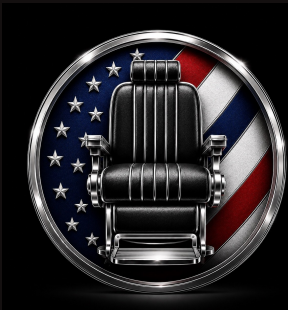

PRIVATE BY DESIGN

FEWER STUDENTS. MORE CORRECTION.

You are not here to get lost in a class of 15 or 20 people. Private sessions and non-regulated practice are normally organized one on one, and never with more than three students per time slot. The goal is to observe, correct, and accelerate real learning. In regulated OJT, the limit is two students per instructor at a time.

CLEAR DURATION, ACCESS AND RATIOS

Bronze, Gold, and Personalized show a standard duration and can be accelerated in writing if the student adds sessions, completes the practice work, and stays on track. Platinum and Diamond include a nine-month academic plan; that calendar does not replace the state path. OJT training requires 12 months, 1,920 hours, and a maximum of 192 hours per month. Everyone receives lifetime access to the included digital edition, subject to technical continuity and platform rules; it does not include unlimited mentoring.

Pages, revisions, ownership, domain, hosting, platforms, photography, and delivery dates are specified in the agreement; unlimited work is never assumed. Verified 2026 reference: a licensed barber school in South Carolina costs between \$19,000 and \$22,000 in tuition, kit, and fees; Platinum also includes brand, website, business, finances, and launch. They are different paths with different rules; compare with information.

The academic phase lasts nine months, but the state path continues until every step is complete. If OJT is activated, it requires a valid permit, an instructor and barbershop with active licenses, an approved curriculum, 12 months, and 1,920 verifiable hours. After passing the exams, the supervised state apprentice stage begins. The Board decides the license.

- Human practice only where written professional authority and verified legal conditions exist.

IDEAL FOR

The eligible professional. Professionals who already hold the health or professional authority required in their jurisdiction and can document it before enrolling.

INVESTMENT

Professional SMP (3 days): \$3,900 — only with legal eligibility documented before enrolling. Theory SMP (2 days): \$1,450 — open to everyone; theoretical education and inert materials, no practice on people. Machine and pigment kit: optional, quoted separately. See page 14: payments.

ENROLLMENT CONDITION

Jurisdiction, credential, and scope are verified before any charge. Without documented authorization, content is limited to theoretical education and inert materials; there is no practice on people.

In South Carolina, current rules restrict micropigmentation/permanent cosmetics to legally authorized healthcare professionals and prohibit tattooing the head, face, or neck outside that scope. This training grants no license or authorization to practice.

TRANSPARENCY BEFORE YOU BEGIN

ONE PRICE. ZERO INTEREST. EVERYTHING IN WRITING.

The payment plan costs exactly the same as paying in full: zero interest and zero finance charges. Only a deposit is required to reserve your spot and your start date. Anyone who pays in full on day one receives a program bonus defined in the agreement (additional sessions or extra mentoring), never a different price. No enrollment is activated until every applicable term is delivered in writing.

RESERVATION DEPOSIT

The deposit reserves your spot and your date (maximum 3 students per time slot). It is 100% refundable within 3 business days of signing; after that it is non-refundable, but it can be transferred once to another start date within 90 days. Every plan payment applies to the total price; payments end together with the program.

FINANCIAL PROTECTION

Before you sign a plan, the offer must show the cash price, amount financed, finance charge, annual percentage rate (APR) when applicable, total of payments, deposit, dates, number of installments, cancellation, and refund. This catalog is not, by itself, a final offer of credit.

EVERYTHING IN WRITING

A CLEAR AGREEMENT PROTECTS BOTH SIDES.

Every student receives a specific agreement before their program is activated. The signature confirms that both sides understand the scope, the calendar, the price, and their responsibilities.

THE INSTRUCTOR COMMITS TO

- Deliver the agreed content and sessions.
- Correct honestly and document progress.
- Maintain safety, privacy, and the applicable ratio: maximum three in private training and two per instructor in OJT.
- Activate the included content, materials, and assets.
- Guide on exams, documents, or continuity when applicable.

THE STUDENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR

- Attending, practicing, studying, and communicating absences.
- Meeting payments, documents, and applicable hours.
- Respecting hygiene, tools, models, and people.
- Accepting corrections and keeping professional conduct.
- Completing homework, evaluations, and completion requirements.

THE AGREEMENT DEFINES

- Level, content, frequency, duration, changes, and make-ups; price, deposit, installments, late payments, cancellation, and refund.
- Loaned tools, delivered equipment, materials, consumables, certificates, letter, website, brand identity, photos, and additional assets.
- Permissions, data, image, safety, external costs, liability limits and, on the state path, a signed receipt of the License Guide.

Tool rule: in-person practice has equipment available for learning. A take-home kit is included only in Diamond, or when the exact list appears in the signed agreement.

BEFORE A SINGLE HOUR CAN COUNT

YOUR LICENSE GUIDE. IT STARTS WITH THE PERMIT.

Platinum and Diamond include a compliance guide for the state path. The student must gather the documents, obtain the correct permit, and keep it valid; the course cannot replace these requirements.

- Choose your credential: Registered Barber does not include reserved chemical services; Master Hair Care includes chemical services and requires an active MHC instructor.
- Age and education: 16 for apprentice, 17 for an unrestricted Registered Barber, and 9th grade or equivalent.
- Enter a school, an approved high school program, or Board-approved OJT under an authorized instructor.
- Wait for the Student Permit to be issued: the application alone does not activate enrollment or hours.
- Keep the permit, the instructor's license, and the school or barbershop license active.

STUDENT PERMIT CHECKLIST

- Completed application and the current non-refundable state fee.
- Valid official ID and a copy of your Social Security card.
- Proof of 9th grade or equivalent and the School/Shop Affidavit.
- Verification of Lawful Presence, signed and notarized.
- 2 x 2 passport-style photo, white background, taken in the last six months; no selfies.
- TB result less than one year old showing no contagious tuberculosis.
- Legal name change and SLED report/court documents, when applicable.

RULES THAT PROTECT YOUR HOURS

The permit does not transfer. If you change schools or OJT instructors, you must surrender the permit and apply for another. The Board issues up to two ordinary permits; the third requires an explanation, the fourth requires an appearance and can be denied. No additional permits are issued after the fourth.

No hour performed before the permit is issued, or under a school, barbershop, or instructor with an expired license, counts toward the state total.

YOUR RECORDS ARE PART OF YOUR LICENSE

OJT COMPLIANCE. EVERY MONTH COUNTS.

Before the Board issues the OJT permit, student and instructor appear together before a Board representative. Hours are valid only when the permit, the location, the supervision, and the reports meet state rules.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Keep a valid OJT permit, tied to that barbershop, displayed with a photo at the station.
- Sign daily attendance and verify that hours are real and complete.
- Have your kit, book, workbook, and implements; receive at least one hour of theory daily.
- Complete every chapter evaluation and keep evidence of progress.
- Review, sign, and receive a copy of the monthly hours report.
- Report changes of instructor, location, permit, or license immediately.

INSTRUCTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Keep the instructor and barbershop licenses active during every reported hour.
- Supervise directly; an OJT student can never be left unsupervised.
- Train a maximum of two OJT students per instructor at the same time.
- Submit the monthly report, even with zero hours, no later than the 10th, and give the student a copy.
- Keep the report, daily sheet, tests, and records available for inspection.
- Upon completion: deliver a transcript by subject and return the Student Permit to the Board.

MANDATORY MONTHLY CYCLE

1 | RECORD

Daily clock-in, clock-out, practice, and instruction.

2 | VERIFY

Hours, signatures, permit, and active licenses.

3 | SUBMIT

Report to the Board by the 10th, with a copy to the student.

False, incomplete, or unsupervised hours, or hours under expired licenses, can be rejected. Course intensity cannot reduce the 12 months or the 1,920 OJT hours. Upon completion, the student registers with the provider for the exam and the single, non-renewable 90-day work permit; that permit is temporary and does not replace the Apprentice Application or the license.

THE COMPLETE SEQUENCE

TRAINING. EXAM. APPRENTICESHIP. LICENSE.

Completing the course or the training hours does not, by itself, produce an unrestricted license. The Board reviews each stage and first issues the apprentice credential when applicable. Documented minimum regulatory costs: \$327 Registered Barber or \$347 Master Hair Care, not counting tuition or external expenses.

PERMIT AND TRAINING

Complete 1,500 hours at a barber college, 1,540 at an approved high school, or 12 months/1,920 OJT hours. Only valid hours count.

2

EXAM APPLICATION

Submit the \$45 application, affidavit or transcript, Social Security, ID, education, lawful presence, photo, TB, and applicable documents.

3

NIC THEORY AND PRACTICAL

The Board must declare you eligible. Theory: \$78. Practical: \$89. Pass both with 70%; authorized early testing does not reduce the hours.

4

REGISTERED BARBER APPRENTICE

Submit the Barber Apprentice Application and identify a BRB/BMH supervisor and a location with active licenses. The Board decides the issuance; you cannot operate a barbershop.

5

UNRESTRICTED LICENSE

Complete 12 months and 1,920 hours as an apprentice. Then submit the Upgrade Form, the supervisor certification, and the fee: \$80 RB or \$100 MHC. The Board decides.

Apprentice stage: direct supervision by an active BRB/BMH in a barbershop or salon with an active license; a cosmetology license alone does not authorize supervising, and hours under inactive licenses do not count. Minimum ages: 16 for apprentice and 17 for Registered Barber.

SIGNED RECEIPT

To activate a state path, the student signs that they received the License Guide, understand their obligations, and acknowledge that only the South Carolina Board of Barber Examiners can issue the license.
